### The Inspiration

Garon Park is a cherished 200-acre green space, kindly bequeathed by Norman Garon to benefit primarily young people in the local community. Nestled in St Luke's Ward, one of the most disadvantaged areas in the UK, it stands as a vital oasis of nature and possibility. Philip Tolhurst - Chairman of the Norman Garon Trust (NGT) comments "When Clive Shiret first approached me with his ideas for using the land, I could instantly see the fit. The scale and ambition of his plan was exciting and suited our own trajectory."

In Southend, access to green spaces falls critically short. The area offers less than half the recommended provision, placing it in the bottom 5% of local authorities for public park availability and in the bottom 20% for tree canopy coverage. These environmental deficits are not just aesthetic concerns, they also have profound implications for the local community, affecting health, wellbeing and social inclusion.

The lack of natural spaces disproportionately affects our vulnerable communities, limiting opportunities for active lifestyles, mental restoration and community connection. This imbalance is especially stark in our schools, where the absence of green environments restricts children's opportunities for healthy physical development, creative exploration, and cognitive growth.

However, the future vision for Garon Park is one of hope and transformation. It was specifically designed to be a catalyst for Climate Justice, and a living example of sustainable and inclusive development. NGT established the popular Garon Park Golf Complex and are working closely with the Garon Park Community Interest Company (CIC) around environmental issues, youth provision and community resilience, underpinning our joint approach into the future.

Garon Park CIC is fostering a healthier, more balanced, and resilient future, where community, environment, and opportunity thrive together. This vision is reflected in the park's growing popularity, with over 210,000 visitors in 2024 alone, including 46,000 who accessed the Well Being Garon Park facilities.

#### The Peter Butler Oval

Peter and Linley Butler first got involved at Garon Park in the 1990s when Essex Cricket were looking for a new home in Southend and through their EASST charity, together with Joe Sims and donors to the charity, they raised and spent significant funds on installing the magnificent Garon Park Festival Cricket Ground, the start of their Collection, which was quickly followed by the Nets. In 2014, Peter was a founding Director of Garon Park CIC and his passion for cricket, football and youth development fitted perfectly with the other Board members and he served until his passing in 2021. Rachel, Peter's daughter, has joined Linley in administering EASST and their passion for sporting development is unabated. They have added to the 'EASST Collection' with the Southend United Community Trust School premises.

Peter was a long term planner and understood the need for term provision to be made to ensure facilities were fit for purpose and since 2014 oversaw the refurbishment of the scoreboard, the updating of the cricket equipment (site screens etc) and had the pitch relaid. It also means that **EASST** make generous donations each year towards the maintenance of the site and ensures Essex Cricket have 40 days of top class facility for their development teams and senior fixtures. In tribute to Peter's passion, drive and commitment to Garon Park, the Cricket Ground has been named **The Peter Butler Oval** in his

# BIG Community Projects

Garon Park presents strategic opportunities for investment in large-scale, community-led capital projects. Through inclusive programmes and green infrastructure, the park fosters social connection, wellbeing and belonging. As a growing hub of community life, it offers measurable social value and long-term impact.

These developments are ideal for major investors seeking to align capital with purpose and help deliver sustainable, community-focused outcomes with lasting social legacy.

#### Extended Sports Pitches and Facilities £3.5m (or component parts)

This capital investment opportunity will significantly expand Garon Park's capacity for youth and community sport, enabling over 10,000 additional youth sporting experiences per month. The development includes:

- A state-of-the-art 3G football pitch (£1.2m)
- A Gen 2 hockey pitch (£800k)
- Purpose-built machine sheds and equipment yard (£200k)
- A community café to drive footfall and revenue (£300k)
- Modern changing room facilities (£800km)

This project offers high social return alongside long-term operational sustainability, making it an attractive prospect for investors seeking to deliver measurable impact in health, youth development and community engagement.



#### New Clubhouse £4.5m

The new clubhouse will be a flexible, purpose-built facility designed to host social events, seminars, workshops and youth activities. With multiple adaptable rooms, it offers strong potential for community impact and income generation through bookings and partnerships. An ideal investment for those seeking to support high-utility, socially driven infrastructure with lasting value.

#### Scoreboard conversion to multi-activity barn £400k

We plan to transform the scoreboard building into a flexible indoor hub for year-round community use. This welcoming space will host diverse activities, bringing people of all ages together to connect, participate and strengthen community resilience.

#### Welcome Centre £40k

A vibrant, purpose-built hub at the heart of Garon Park, the Welcome Centre will serve as the first point of contact for visitors — offering orientation, site information and engagement opportunities. It will inspire involvement in community programmes, including citizen science and environmental initiatives, while also providing essential staff support to ensure a welcoming and well-managed visitor experience. This small but high-impact investment will play a key role in connecting people, enhancing footfall and fostering deeper community participation.

#### Indoor Cricket Centre £3m

A flagship addition to Garon Park, this state-of-the-art Indoor Cricket Centre will serve both grassroots and elite-level sport and will feature:

- 6 professional-grade indoor lanes
- High-tech batting analysis centre
- Outdoor and arass nets for year-round training
- Modern changing facilities
- Social and spectator areas for events and community use

Designed to attract schools, clubs, county teams and national programmes, the centre offers strong income potential through hire, coaching, memberships and events.

As an investor for this development, you will directly help to deliver elite-standard cricket facilities, meaningful youth development and engagement, sustainable revenue streams and a lasting legacy for sport and community wellbeing.

#### The Explorer Base £480k (or component parts)

The Explorer Base will be an exciting and imaginative outdoor facility designed to give children and families a taste of adventure, learning and fun, right in the heart of Garon Park. It will include:

- 6 x covered adventure huts for group stays or activities (£60k) per hut
- Bespoke kids' outdoor adventure playground (£20k)
- Toilet and shower block for comfort and accessibility (£40k)
- A lively on-site café to serve visitors and generate revenue (£60k)

This playful development offers a unique opportunity to invest in a space that promotes outdoor learning, exploration and overnight experiences for youth groups, schools and families. It combines fun, freedom and social value, creating memorable experiences while supporting wellbeing, confidence and community connection.

# The Hive and Youth projects in action

Vic Thomas became involved in Garon Park from 2014 when Garon Park CIC was formed and has been a committed advocate of the aims of the site. The Club Room is a vital part of social life at Garon Park and Vic ensured the finance was in place together with various infrastructure additions to make the site a safe place. In the formative years of Wellbeing at Garon Park, Vic through his company Hivedome, was instrumental in ensuring the charity was able to develop, with a longterm commitment to annual funding which covered the basic overheads of the charity and allowed it to go about its business without a funding shadow. #### Youth Projects

#### Youth Hut and dedicated outdoor space £60k

The Youth Hut is at the heart of the Garon Park Youth Programme, a safe, welcoming space where young people can socialise, build friendships and take part in fun, enriching activities. It fosters confidence, creativity and connection, supporting their social and emotional growth in a space where they truly belong.



### Young leaders training £1k per course

Our leaders will receive essential training that ensures they stay current with health and safety standards while also developing new skills to support their personal growth and future careers. This investment fosters a culture of learning, confidence, and care that benefits the whole community.

#### Sponsor confidence building courses for girls £1k per course

This investment will support a vital programme designed to empower young girls by boosting their self-esteem, fostering healthy friendships and providing guidance through the challenges of adolescence, helping them develop the confidence and resilience needed to thrive and succeed.

#### Sponsor A Youth Worker £35k per annum

Support the recruitment of a dedicated professional to co-develop Garon Park's Youth Council and dynamic youth programme. This role will also lead local outreach to connect with underserved young people and promote the opportunities available to them. A high-impact investment in youth leadership, inclusion and long-term community growth.

# Environmental Projects

Garon Park is a wildlife hotspot, a real biodiversity island within a sea of development. The team are working in partnership with the Norman Garon Trust to design and develop an ongoing conservation programme across the 200-acre site. This provides many opportunities for environmental legacy projects, some current examples of which are:

#### Building of our Conservation Hub £80k

This hub will create a hive of activity all year round. One where our community can come together and enjoy a rich variety of programmes, group activities. It will be a space where creativity meets calm through using natural resources and careful planning to ensure sustainability is at its core.

#### Woodland Sponsorship Opportunity £12k & £1200 annual maintenance

Sponsor a half-acre within a 6.5-acre Essex-native woodland designed to preserve local ecology and offer educational experiences in traditional crafts. This investment supports sustainable environmental restoration and community engagement, providing lasting social and ecological impact.

### Wildflower Meadow Planting £500 & £300 annual maintenance

Join us in creating extensive wildflower meadows and native habitats across Garon Park. This large-scale project will boost biodiversity, support pollinators and promote sustainability, shaping a resilient natural landscape that benefits both wildlife and the community.

#### Rewilding programmes £5k

Rewilding is at the very heart of Garon Park. Projects are already underway to restore nature's intricate ecosystems across the 200-acre site, allowing nature to be able to take care of herself and therefore us once again, creating habitats and natural processes to encourage species expansion through this large-scale restoration project.

#### Citizen science £5k per science project

Cultivating and maintaining species through surveying and biodiversity monitoring to measure environmental impact. These programmes encourage the community to embrace all that is nature around them and bring their new skills and techniques together for the good of the land.

### Orchard Planting and Maintenance £500 & £75 annual maintenance

This is a unique opportunity to join 'The Collection' by sponsoring the planting and ongoing care of a single tree. Each tree can be dedicated to your family or business and will feature a commemorative plaque at its location, creating a lasting legacy within the community.
